

## SUGGESTED SCHEDULE OF WELL VISITS

<u>AGE</u>	<u>IMMUNIZATION/SCREENING TEST</u>
BIRTH	HepB (In Hospital)
2-5 Days	Weight, Feeding, Jaundice Check (Day after Discharge for Breast Fed Babies)
8-14 Days	Physical Exam, Repeat PKU (All Babies)
4 Weeks	Physical Exam, HepB (4 Weeks from Day of Discharge from Nursery)
2 Months	Physical Exam, Prevnar, Rota Rix, Pentacel (DTaP, IPV, Hib)
4 Months	Physical Exam, Prevnar, Rota Rix, Pentacel (DTaP, IPV, Hib)
6 Months	Physical Exam, Prevnar, Pentacel (DTaP, IPV, Hib)
9 Months	Physical Exam, HepB
12 Months	Physical Exam, Prevnar, Varivax, MMR, HgB, Lead Screen
15 Months	Physical Exam, Hib, DTaP
18 Months	Physical Exam, HepA #1 (Please check with your insurance coverage for 18 month physical exams.)
2 Years	Physical Exam, HepA #2, HgB, Lead Screen
30 Month	Physical Exam
3 Years	Physical Exam
4 Years	Physical Exam, Urine Sample, Kinrix (DTaP, IPV), MMR, Varivax
5 Years	Physical Exam, (May receive MMR and Varivax if it was not administered at 4 year well visit)

(Check with your child's doctor for the frequency of Physical Exams between ages 6 and 11.  
Please note - In order for us to complete any health forms we will need a recent annual Physical Exam.)

9 Years and older cholesterol check

11-12 Years	Physical Exam, Menveo or Menactra, TdaP ( Boostrix or Adacel), Gardasil
13 Years	Physical Exam, Gardasil (if not received at 11-12 Years)
14-15 Years	Physical Exam, Urine Sample at 14 years of age. Menveo or Menactra (if not received at 11-12 Years), Gardasil (if not received at 11-12 Years)
16-18 Years	Menveo or Menactra and MenB, 17-19 years old cholesterol check #2

Entrance to College - Physical Exam, Menveo or Menactra and MenB (if not previously received)

Flu Vaccine Yearly for 6 months of age and older.

DTaP - Diphtheria, Tetanus, Acellular Pertussis Vaccine

Prevnar - Pneumococcal 13-Valent Conjugate Vaccine

Hib - Haemophilus Influenza Vaccine

MMR - Measles, Mumps, Rubella Vaccine

HgB - Hemoglobin - Screen for Anemia

Menactra or Menveo - Meningitis Vaccine

Rota Rix - Rotavirus Vaccine

Gardasil (HPV) - Human papillomavirus Vaccine

IPV - Injectable Polio Vaccine

Varivax - Chicken Pox Vaccine

HebB - Hepatitis B Vaccine

TdaP - Tetanus, Diphtheria, Acellular Pertussis Vaccine

ProQuad - MMR and Varivax Combined

HepA - Hepatitis A Vaccine

Pentacel - DTaP, IPV, Hib Vaccines

Kinrix - DTaP, IPV Vaccines

MenB - Meningitis B Vaccine
